

Revelation Chapter's 6 & 7 Homework

Read through Revelation chapter's 6 & 7, take notes on anything that speaks to you or you have questions on. You can then answer the questions below and we will cover these chapters at our next study. Make sure to bring your completed homework with you for our small group time.

Look back at Revelation 1:19..Where do chapters 6 & 7 fall into as far as the timeline of events Jesus told John to write about?

We see that the scroll has seven seals..Look back through your notes and the previous 5 chapters of Revelation and list all the different sevens we have seen so far:

Where do we first see the number seven pertaining to something in scripture?

Who was it in Revelation 5:5 that spoke to John?

Who do we find speaking when the seals are opened in Revelation 6?

Without doing any studying or research, who do you think is riding upon the white horse?

What does the rider on the red horse bring take from and bring upon earth?

In 6:8 John declares that “they [the four horsemen] were given power” to kill. Who gave them that power and why?

Who rode upon the pale horse, and what methods did it use? What does Hades refer to?

What group of people do we see in Revelation 6:9?

What is it that they wanted the Lord to do?

What were they given in verse 11 and where in the previous 5 chapters of Revelation have we seen these mentioned?

In Revelation 7 what do we find the four angels doing?

List scripture address of at least 3 other passages where God had control of the wind or or used wind in someway as a punishment:

If we follow the thought that the rapture of the church happened prior to the events of chapter 6 & 7, this would indicate that those on the earth during the tribulation still have an opportunity to receive salvation. What does this tell us about our God?

All through the Old Testament we see records of genealogies. Maybe you've found yourself skipping over some of those long chapters of hard to pronounce names. Those very list' remind us of how thorough our God is. How does it allow you to see God when we take into consideration that He is keeping track of all those from these twelve tribes of Israel?

Look back at Revelation 6:17..Who do you think was asking this question which was actually more of a statement?

Here in chapter 7 with these 144,000 Jews being sealed, how does that answer the question in 6:17?

Look-up Gen. 41:42, Esther 3:10, 8:2, Dan. 6:17 & Matthew 27:66..From these verses and your foreknowledge, what does the signet ring and seal signify?

Read Ephesians 1:13 and 4:30...Are you as a believer in Christ sealed?

What does Eph. 4:30 tell us the were sealed for, who does this make you feel?

We see the 144,000 sealed, but who are those we see before the throne in Rev. 7:13,14?
