<p>Lesson 1</p>	<p>Scripture to Read:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1 Corinthians 1:1-9</p>
<p>Questions to discuss with Kids</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Who did Paul write the letter of 1 Corinthians too? Check out verse 2. 2. What does Paul not want the Corinthians to be lacking in? See verse 7. 3. Who sustains us until the end? Look at verses 7-8. Who is faithful to us? See verse 9. What do you think the word “Faithful” means? What are ways we can show faithfulness to others?
<p>Craft Idea Items Needed: Paper, markers, stickers</p>	<p>“The Revealing of Jesus Christ” Craft- We are waiting for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ. Kids will make a craft to show the revealing of Jesus. You will need one piece of white paper. Fold it in half, top over bottom. Draw a square in the center of the paper. Cut out the two side lines and bottom line (make sure to only cut the top piece, not the back piece of paper). This will create a door flap. Have your kids draw a picture of Jesus under the door flap. Close the door flap and write on it, “as you wait for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ.” 1 Corinthians 1:7b. Decorate around the door with stickers.</p>
<p>Game Idea Items Needed: Music</p>	<p>Jesus Sustains! Exercise Activity- Just like exercise builds up our muscles, Jesus builds us up and sustains us! We’re going to have fun sustaining our muscles through exercise. Play some upbeat music. Call out an exercise for the kids to do. When the music stops, the kids stop the exercise and then a new exercise starts. Here are some exercise ideas: jumping jacks, run in place, sit ups, push-ups and squats.</p>
