

## “Be Built Up” A Study through 1 Corinthians for Kids!

<b>Lesson 15</b>	<b>Scripture to Read:</b> 1 Corinthians 16:12-24
<b>Questions to discuss with Kids</b>	<p>1. Paul ends his letter to the Corinthians with some final instructions. What does Paul want the believers to do? Check out verses 13-14.</p> <p>2. Who refreshed Paul’s spirit? Check out verses 17-18 to find out. What are some ways we can refresh other people’s spirits?</p> <p>3. Who are we waiting to come? See verse 22. If Jesus were to come back today, what would you want to say to Him? What do you think you would do?</p>
<b>Craft Idea</b> Items Needed: *Pipe cleaners, paper	<b>“Be Watchful” Googles-</b> Paul wants us to be watchful and stand firm in the faith. The kids can make some silly googles to remind them to be watchful! Use pipe cleaners to twist and make into the form of a pair of glasses. Write on a small square piece of paper, “Be watchful, stand firm in the faith...” 1 Corinthians 16:13a. Punch a hole through the top of the paper and thread it through an end of one of the pipe cleaners. If you don’t have pipe cleaners, use paper to trace and cut out a pair of glasses and write the verse on the side of the glasses.
<b>Game Idea</b> Items Needed:	<b>Final Instructions Activities-</b> Kids will get to do the final instructions as listed in verses 13 and 14. <b>Be watchful-</b> Have a staring contest for 1 minute. No one blinks! <b>Stand Firm-</b> Stand on one foot without falling. The person to stand the longest, wins! <b>Be Strong-</b> Do 20 push-ups! <b>Let all that you do be done in love-</b> Call a family member on the phone and tell them you love them.
