After the war in Heaven, the Dragon and his angels were thrown down to Earth. Look at what the voice said in Heaven from Revelation 12 verses 10-12. Looking at verse 10, whose kingdom has now come? Who has the ultimate authority?</li> <li>2. What are the two ways that Christians can conquer the Dragon? Check out verse 11.</li> <li>3. Who is the Lamb mentioned in verse 11? Look up John 1:36 to find out!</li> <li>4. What is a testimony as talked about in verse 11? How do you think someone’s testimony of Jesus can help them overcome the Devil?</li> <li>5. Is the Devil’s time on Earth for a super long time or a short time? See verse 12.</li> <li>6. In Revelation 13:15, the Second Beast will cause everyone to worship the Image of the First Beast. Who does God want us to worship? Look up Matthew 22:37.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>
<p>*Paper, yarn, hole punch, markers *Lots of socks!</p>	<p><b>Upstream Fun Activities-</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>‘Love God’ Heart Necklace Craft-</b> Cut out a four-inch heart from construction paper. Help the kids write on the heart, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.” Matthew 22:37. Have the kids color and decorate the heart. Use a hole punch to punch a hole at the top of the heart. Thread yarn through the hole to form a loop big enough to make a necklace. Tie the end pieces together. Kids can wear their necklace to remind them to love God with all their heart!</li> <li>• <b>Sock War! Game-</b> Michael and his angels defeated the Dragon in Heaven. Now let’s have a little fun with our own war...a sock war! Divide the room in half. Form two teams. Give each team a pile of socks. On “Go” throw the socks at one another. After one minute, the Team with the least amount of socks on their side, wins!</li> </ul>
