

**“Be Built Up”**  
**A Study through 2 Corinthians for Kids!**

<p><b>Lesson 9</b></p>	<p><b>Scripture to Read: 2 Corinthians 9:6-15</b></p>
<p><b>Questions to discuss with Kids</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. If you give a little how much will you receive? See verse 6.</li> <li>2. Money is one way to give, what are some other ways we can give?</li> <li>3. What type of giver does God love? Check out verse 7.</li> </ol>
<p><b>Craft Idea</b>  Items Needed:  *Paper plates, pennies, glue, markers</p>	<p><b>Penny Plate Craft-</b> Give each kid a paper plate. While looking at a penny, help them outline Abraham Lincoln onto the plate. Write, “In God We Trust” at the top, write the date on the right-hand side and “...for God loves a cheerful giver.” 2 Cor. 9:7b at the bottom. Glue a couple of pennies on each side of the plate. Kids can then color the plate. Encourage the kids to give to God with a cheerful heart!</p>
<p><b>Game Idea</b>  Items Needed:  *5 paper cups  *Several Pennies</p>	<p><b>“He Has Distributed Freely” Penny Toss Game!</b> Set out 5 paper cups. Write portions of this verse on the cups, “He has distributed freely, He has given to the poor; His righteousness endures forever.” 2 Cor. 9:9b. Place the paper cups in a line on the table. Give to each kid 5 pennies. Kids will take turns tossing their pennies into the cups. Try variations of the game by having the kids toss the penny with their thumb, right eye closed, toss the penny while humming and toss the penny while standing on one foot! Remind the kids that God loves a cheerful giver!</p>

***Got extra time? Here’s an idea—Thankful to God for His inexpressible gift! Have the family sit in a circle and take turns sharing what gift God has given them that they are thankful for.***
