Who will be bound by a chain for a thousand years? Look at verse 2. What do you think the earth will be like with the dragon not on it?</li> <li>2. Who will be reigning with Jesus during the 1,000 years? Check out verse 4. Along with those who were martyred for Jesus, all believes in Jesus will be reigning with Him as well. Take a look at 2 Timothy 2:12 and Revelation 3:21 for more background on Jesus’ reign.</li> <li>3. What do you think it will be like to have Jesus as King on the Earth? *Card making supplies and an envelope *Books	<p><b>Upstream Fun Activities-</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>“Share Jesus” Card Making Activity-</b> Revelation 20:6a says, “Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first resurrection!..” We want all of our loved ones to be a part of that first resurrection! Make a card to share about Jesus to a loved one. Get a plain piece of paper, fold it in half (make sure it will fit inside of an envelope) and write on it, “Jesus loves you and so do I.” Decorate the card with stickers and then mail it to a loved one. Remember to pray for them!</li> <li>• <b>“Book Balance Race!”-</b> All those whose names are written in the Book of Life will live forever with Jesus! To celebrate let’s have a Book Balancing Race! First set up a playing area in a room with a start line (can use random objects on the ground) on one side of the room and a finish line. Have two people play at a time. Give them each 1-2 books to balance on their heads. On “Go” they walk slowly to the finish line. First one there wins! Have the next set of people go. Make it a tournament and have various people race against each other. For more of a challenge, add more books on top of their heads and have them walk with their eyes closed!</li> <li>• <b>“King for a Day!”-</b> Select someone to be the “King.” Have everyone else stand about 10 feet away from the “King.” The “King” will give out silly instructions for the family to follow, if they don’t follow the instructions they’re out. The last one left is the new “King!” Some silly instructions: Stand on one foot and jump up and down, Sit on the ground and sing a song with your tongue out, Put your socks on your hands, Do 10 jumping jacks while singing “God Bless America” in an opera voice, Scoot on the ground from one side of the room to the other while barking like a dog and make fish faces while pretending to swim in the room.</li> </ul>
