Saved by Faith - A Study through Galatians for Kids!

Galatians 1:1-10

Discussion Questions

After reading this lesson's scripture, discuss these with your kids!

1. Who made Paul an apostle? (v. 1)
2. What did Jesus do for us? (verses 3-4)
3. What was the problem the churches in Galatia had? (v. 6) The word gospel means good news. Share with each other the good news of Jesus Christ!

Craft Time

Items Needed:

- Construction paper
- Markers

“Gospel” Craft – The gospel according to 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 is that: Jesus died for our sins, Jesus was buried and Jesus raised on the third day. Make a tri-fold Gospel craft showing each part of the gospel.

- First, vertically fan fold an 8 x10 piece of construction paper creating three sections.
- Next, label each section the three parts of the gospel message listed above.
- Finally, use markers to draw a description of each gospel section.

Let's Play

Items Needed:

- Paper
- Markers
- Prizes

“Who Do You Please?” Talent Show! – Select some family members to be the judges. One volunteer will be a talent show contestant. The judges will give a judgement for each talent performed (make sure to give high scores!).

- First, give each judge a couple pieces of paper and a marker.
- Next, the first volunteer will perform a talent for the judges.
- The judges will write down a score of 1-10 on their paper and show it. Keep playing until everyone gets a chance to perform a talent. Give a prize to all who participated! Share with the kids that we are to seek to please God first in all we do.

Here's an idea to try!

“Deliverer” Tag! – Find an open space to play this game of tag. Select one person to be “The Tagger” and one person to be “The Deliverer.” Designate a place to be the “Stuck Spot.” “The Tagger” will run and tag family members and take them to the “Stuck Spot.” “The Deliverer” can save people out of the “Stuck Spot” by tapping their shoulder. People can only be saved two times from the “Stuck Spot” and on the third time they become “The Tagger.” Let's praise God that Jesus is the Deliverer for us!
