

## **Saved by Faith -** A Study through Galatians for Kids!

Galatians 4:1-20

# **Discussion Questions**

After reading this lesson's scripture, discuss these with your kids!

- 1. Why did God send His Son Jesus? (verses 4-5)
- 2. When we are redeemed by Jesus what do we receive? (v. 5)
- 3. What has God sent into our hearts when we become His sons? (v. 6) What does the Spirit cry out? (v. 6)

### **Craft Time**

#### **Items Needed:**

- o 8x10 white paper
- Markers/crayons
- Scissors

#### "Family of God" Paper Craft - Create a paper family holding hands to resemble the family of God!

- First, cut an 8x10 piece of white paper in half horizontally. Use one of the halves. Fold the half three times using a fan fold method (fold, flip over fold again, three times).
- Next, outline a person on one of the folded parts. Make sure the hands and feet touch the sides of the paper (this will ensure the paper people will connect after cutting them out).
- Finally, cut the person out, unfold and there is a family holding hands! Write on the paper family, "...so that we might receive adoption as sons." Galatians 4:5b. Use crayons or markers to color in the people.

# Let's Play

#### Items Needed:

- Decorations & Snacks
- o Music

"Adoption Party!" – When a child is adopted into a family, the family throws a party! Throw a family party to celebrate your adoption into God's family!

- First, decorate the room with streamers, balloons and homemade "Congratulations" signs. Play some music and set out a table with yummy snacks.
- Next, play fun party games! Here are some game ideas: Freeze Dance- everyone dances to music and when the music stops everyone freezes. Balloon Hop- put a balloon between your ankles and hop from one side of the room to the other.

#### **Bonus!**

Have extra time? Here's an idea to try! "Abba! Father!" Activity— Write on the top of a piece of paper, "Abba! Father!" Under "Abba! Father!" write down descriptions of what God has done for us as our Heavenly Father. Some examples are; God cares for us, God loves us and God protects us.
